Mem. That in 1870 the Church was repaired & the
 interior was beautified by
 W. B. Hoker Esq. of Faulkham House
 The Rev. G. Cluff was become Rector of this Parish in 1873
 & died Nov 17th 1887. The Rev. T. Blackhall B.A. Exeter
 was instituted on Feb 22nd 1887 by the Bishop in Exeter
 on the presentation of J. E. B. Brown Esq. of
 Pusey House Barks, & came into Residence March 17th

Mem. On July 16. A new Silver Chalice was presented to
 the Church for use at Holy Com^m (the old being one broken)
 by W. B. Hoker Esq. of Faulkham House, together with a case
 for the Com^m & Vessels

Mem. That 2 dozen Chairs & 2 table lamps were purchased
 for use in the Church, & that Evening Service was
 begun there on Sunday or Oct 25 & continued on
 every Sunday through the winter; in the Spring it was
 presented by W. B. Hoker Esq. & Mr. Philip Barks Esq. of
 Faulkham House for use at the School services

Mem. That two Prayer Books, one Book of Offices & one
 Book of Common Prayer were purchased for use in the Church in Dec 28th 1880 out
 of the profits of an Entertainment given on the 11th

Mem. That the Church was re-ordered at the same time
 by the expense of W. B. Hoker Esq. & Mr. Philip Barks Esq.
 to the value of £1000 in the Church year
